General Business

1. 2017 Race Medallions: VHA Medallions were distributed at the beginning of General Business
2. Building Alterations: John Brislin asked that the Delegates thank Andrew Spiliopoulos for the good work he and his workers have done. Andrew Spiliopoulos wished to thank, Jeff Weaver, John Yates, Jim Cerin and Peter McDonough for their help with cleaning and moving equipment.
3. 2018 National Race: Andrew Spiliopoulos confirmed that the race will be from Dubbo
4. First Club Race from Rochester: The VHA trailer is registered for road use from 1st July to 31st December. Therefore basketing for the first race will be held on Saturday 30th June, for a Sunday 1st July race.
5. Long Distance Special Meeting at VPU Rooms: Andrew Spiliopoulos met with representatives of other feds in a meeting organised by John Share at the VPU rooms regarding a committee being formed to organise long distance racing for all feds.
After some discussion it was decided that to attract savings in transport and provide greater cover for the pigeons, the VHA would conduct its long distance racing and invite all feds on the VHA transporter. A VHA race result will be calculated together with a "National Type" result as well. All feds to be invited to a meeting in late April to discuss The Presidents and Secretaries and one other representative from each Fed to be invited attend.
