(A). Young Bird Derby

Option One – The 3rd 240 mile race to be the Young Bird Derby. Standard 50 bird limit, Yearlings only. No extra race.

Option Two – An additional race on the day of the 3rd 240 mile race with a separate liberation. 30 bird limit. Yearlings only.

VHA, WPF, GMPF, VPU, VPO, PRV 2017 issue rings only in the Young Bird Derby as a Race Condition.

(B). Entry Fee

Option One – Increase of 10 cents for all races

Option Two – Remain the same as 2017 for all races
