4. Reports

Clock Chairman – Nil Report

Ring Secretary- Hank Merbis advised that 20 pigeons were reported & owners notified.

VRPB – Andrew Demidowski (Secretary) & Jeff Weaver (Vice President) Nil Report.

Treasurers Report – Paul Bryant

- Paul Bryant is now a signatory on the bank accounts. Gerry Sheean will stay on as a signatory for all accounts.
- Paul Bryant raised the costs of eftpos in the N Hill rooms as \$41.75 a month. Cheque Acc \$56,055.12 V2 Plus Acc \$55-00 On Line Saver Acc \$70,049.96

A bill of \$122.84 electricity to be paid = quarterly

Race & Finance Meeting

Upfront fees & Race Entry costs discussed

It was recommended that the prices and liberation times for all federation races remain the same as for 2024.

It was recommended that cost of the club race increase from \$0.80 per bird in 2024 to \$1.00 per bird in 2025. An increase of 20 cents per bird.

It was recommended that Carrieton 2 - 500-mile race be a stand-alone race.

It was advised that the North birds will be released 1st for 1st club race

Upfront fee was recommended at \$2.50 per bird to achieve the \$105,000 required to run the VHA in 2025

Expecting 26,000 birds in 2025. Last year 29,000 nominations. John Van Beers advised that in 2025 the VHA will have 12 less members 15% reduction in flyers

Membership \$24,000 @ \$200 per member paid for honorariums \$12,000

In 2025 14,300 rings were predicted - sold 13,000 a drop of around 10 %

Standalone race for 500-mile race Carrieton = normal race and it will be paid for by the people who race it.

The President advised that the race & finance committee can only make recommendations to the delegates who have the final say. Minutes from that meeting will be distributed to all members.

John Van Beers - Spoke in favour of the 2nd 500-mile race. He spoke about the purpose of the VHA and that never in the history of the VHA have they had a standalone race. He advised that every race has always been supported financially by all VHA members. He commented that the recommendation of the race and Finance Committee appears vindictive. He advised that in 2024 there were six long distance races where 47 participated representing 50% of members and that money should be spread over the whole program. Jeff Weaver also spoke in favour of the 2nd five-hundred-mile race. He advised that after the initial DV line of flight (race schedule including 2 x 500's) was agreed to, then it was resubmitted and had changed.

Both Kevin Clark and Stevan Gazzola advised that at the previous Race & Finance Meeting the decision to recommend that the 2nd five hundred race from Carrieton was simply a monetary one. It was to save the VHA around \$5,000.

Andrew Spiliopoulos advised by basketing at the Notting Hill Centre by all participating flyers in the 500 and 600 mile races will save \$1000s of dollars for the VHA in local transport costs.

To become exempt from Land Tax the VHA need to change its constitution. Charles Hider to advise in due course.

David Wetering advised that he expects the same sponsors as in 2024 will be sponsoring VHA races again. Ten (10) races will be sponsored with prize money of \$ 600 for 1^{st} 300 for 2^{nd} and \$100 for 3^{rd}
