ANNUAL REPORT AND BALANCE SHEET OF THE VICTORIAN HOMING ASSOCIATION

To the Members,

Mr. Chairman and Gentlemen,

I have pleasure in presenting to you the Annual Report and Balance Sheet covering the activities of the Association for the 1947 season, with the sincere wish that it will merit your consideration and approval.

Financial.—Financial results for the year have again been very satisfactory, members' subscriptions exceeding those of last year, establishing a record. The increased membership and greater interest taken in our sport have been of material assistance, and the Association is now in a position to offer more prize money to the compulsory Federation Races. 24,038 metal rings were sold and 2,216 rings were re-registered.

2,775 baskets conveying 64,581 birds to the various race points for liberation, is the greatest number sent forward on any line by the V.H.A.

The racing throughout was closely contested, and the prize money well distributed.

Social.—With all rationing restrictions still in force we find it very hard to offer much in the way of entertainment for members, but the Yarraville, Great Southern and Elsternwick clubs were the most active and did everything expected under the prevailing difficult conditions. At Yarraville a most enjoyable evening was spent by officials of all clubs. The Great Southern Club was not to be denied in this respect. They in turn put on one of the most enjoyable evenings of all, for members and their wives. To wind up the season a very good time was had by members and officials of the V.H.A. at the Elsternwick Social Evening held in the Ormond Pavilion. We owe a debt of gratitude to the officials and members of the above mentioned clubs for these functions, held at their club rooms.

As in previous years, social cricket and all classes of games were played and opportunity was taken to make a picnic for members' wives and children at these popular outings by the Yarraville and Hawthorn Clubs.

Federations.—Prize money paid out was £2,833/18/7, surpassing all records. The most successful member in Federation Aggregate was J. Smith, of the Ivanhoe Club, with 28 points, winning the Trustees' Trophy for the 1947 season.

The Manton Cup for Young Birds aggregate went to Messrs. Catmull and Horman (Northcote) with 17 points. B. Oliver (Malvern) finished with a close second with 16 points. The H. W. Devlin Memorial Cup was won by G. Howie (Malvern).

The Produce Race was won by S. Murphy (Yarraville).

The George Laphorne Commemoration Shield was won by Malvern Club with 72 points, Yarraville running in second place with 51 points.

The Plasschaert Cup went to R. Allen, winner of the Plasschaert Clock Flyers.
